As we wind down to complete another year we reflect on the various opportunities we have had as an organization to both serve and to make a difference in the lives of others. We have been blessed with multiple opportunities to literally save lives and to make our communities safer as exemplified by our annual project which for 2018 is our Active Shooter School Safety Symposium. We should all be proud to know it is the first of it's kind in California with the variety and amount of case studies being offered from throughout the nation! We host and applaud the First Responders, the Survivors and the Hero's that will be presenting at our first Symposium.

2018 REPORT ON VOLUNTEER HOURS AND DONATIONS

As an organization we can be very proud of our continued community service, volunteer hours and donations. This past year our members contributed monthly donations of food to the Carmelite Monastery in Carmel, Ca. valued at \$150.00 per month for a total of \$1800.00 for the year. Members have also donated to our O.S.t.M.A.A. fund over \$3000.00 towards our awards and recognition program. Our members tallied up the following Fraternal Activity for 2018: Caring for sick 208 hours, bereaved visits, 56 hours, 11 blood donors, 464 hours of church service, 2225 hours of community related volunteer services, 470 hours of volunteer service for youth activities, 1053 additional volunteer hours, \$2950.00 in donations on behalf of the Order to charitable or benevolent causes, 785 hours of fraternal service, 156 hours of volunteer service to our veterans, 2280 miles of volunteer travel on behalf of our veterans, \$2372.00 in donations towards veterans causes, 185 hours of volunteer service to First Responders, 1090 miles of volunteer travel on behalf of First Responders, \$2000 in donations towards First Responder causes, 1090 hours towards school safety and \$7881.00 in donations towards school safety. 
